Some history on Noluthando



Noluthando (a place with love) was established in the late '70s by a group of seniors who were lonely, poor and living in challenging conditions in shacks. Their first meeting place was a garage where they shared whatever food they could find and supported each other through their loneliness and the hardships they faced.

The current group is made up of 80 seniors. They meet five times a week with an attendance of between 45 and 50 members per day. Their daily activities include craft, literacy classes, gardening and music. They also participate in "Ger-Olympics", cultural events, the occasional outing and forums in the community where they are able to address community problems and agree on solutions.

Transport is organised to bring the seniors to the centre and return them home after the daily activities.

The group has a committee and manage their own club with the help of a club assistant who is employed by Ikamva Labantu to organise their daily programme.
