Report of the Nominating Committee

October 2005

Pursuant to the provisions of Article 15 of the CMI Constitution, the undersigned, as Chairman of the Nominating Committee, has duly consulted all Member Associations soliciting their views concerning candidates for nomination and election to the position of Administrator and two positions as Executive Councillor, the elections to be held at the 2006 CMI Assembly scheduled for 15 February 2006 in Cape Town.

Replies have been received from the following associations:

Argentina, Belgium, Brazil, Bulgaria, Canada, Chile, China, Denmark, Italy, Japan, Nigeria, Norway, United Kingdom, USA, Venezuela.

There has been almost unanimous support of the re-election of Wim Fransen as Administrator as well as Henry H. Li and José Alcántara as Executive Councillors.

On this basis, the Committee, after due deliberation, has decided to make the following nominations for election at the Cape Town Assembly on 15 February 2006:

Administrator	Wim Fransen (Belgium) for a second term
Executive Councillor	Henry H. Li (People's Republic of China) for a second term
Executive Councillor	José Alcántara (Spain) for a second term

Under Article 15 of the CMI Constitution, Member Associations may, if they so wish, make nominations independently of the Nominating Committee, provided any such independent nominations are forwarded to and received by the CMI Administrator prior to the commencement of the Cape Town Assembly.
